• #1 THE FOUR LIVING CREATURES WORSHIP GOD (Rev. 4:8c)

Isaiah 6:1-3 "In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory."

Leviticus 11:44-45 "For I am the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy."

I Peter 1:13-16 "Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy."

• #2 A SCROLL IN GOD'S RIGHT HAND (Rev. 5:1) Title Deed for the Earth

This Chapter focuses on the seven sealed scroll and who is WORTHY to open it. These seals represent the beginning of Christ's judgment on sinners and the earth during the last 3.5 years of tribulation.

- This Chapter divided into three sections:
- 1. The search for someone who is worthy to open the scroll
- 2. The Lion of the Tribe of Judah, as a Lamb that has been slain, is WORTHY to open the scroll
- 3. A new song is sung and the praise and worship of God and Christ

- **Revelation 5:1** "And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals."
- **Revelation 5:4** "And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals."
- *Ezekiel 2:9-10* "And when I looked, behold, an hand was sent unto me; and, lo, a roll of a book was therein; And he spread it before me; and it was written within and without: and there was written therein lamentations, and mourning, and woe."

• #3 ANGELS SEARCH FOR SOMEONE WORTHY TO OPEN THE SCROLL (Rev. 5:2-3)

- **Revelation 5:2-3** "And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon."
- **Revelation 5:4** "And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon."
- Luke 4:9-12 "And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down from hence: For it is written, He shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee: And in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God."
- *II Corinthians 4:4* "In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them."
