as revealed to the Apostle John • Lesson #21 - June 23rd, 2024

Revelation Chapter 5 is focused on praising and worshipping Christ

Revelation 5:6-8 "And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne. And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints."

#1 THE BEASTS (WHO REPRESENT CREATION RECONCILED) ARE ANGELIC BEINGS (Rev. 5:8A)

Revelation 5:8 "And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints."

Romans 8:18 "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."

Romans 8:19 "For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God."

Romans 8:20 "For the *creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope,

Romans 8:21 "Because the *creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God."

Romans 8:22 "For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now."

Romans 8:23 "And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body."

(*Creatures referenced refers to the animal kingdom that suffered the consequences of our sin.)

• #2 THE 24 ELDERS REPRESENT THE CHURCH WHO HAVE GOLDEN VIALS FULL OF THE PRAYERS OF SAINTS (Rev. 5:8B)

Ten Suggestive Prayers from the Pastor for us:
